### **USFE Release 1.0 Frontend Installation Kits for Simulation**

The USFE R1.0 Frontend Installation Kits for Simulation are currently being distributed via the network. The distribution started **December 1** and will continue through **December 5, 2006**. USFE R1.0 Frontend Installation Kits for Simulation will be available in the following MISS directories on the report nodes defined by the member:

SUN Solaris (MISS): /opt/gate/transferdir/release41/sun  
Windows (MISS): <ftp-root directory>\release41\win

To ensure a successful reception of the Simulation kits, MISS systems must be reachable via the network (ftp and ftp-login must be possible). In addition there must be approximately 120 MB disk space available to store the kit on the MISS.

For installation instructions, please refer to the "readme" files provided with the USFE R1.0 Frontend Installation Kits and the respective USFE R1.0 Frontend Installation Guide.
